Please note that your application is not complete until you have also submitted:

1. A complete, official transcript of your academic record. Please send a copy of your transcript in the format Lastname\_Firstname\_Transcript.

2. Two (2) letters of recommendation commenting on your scholastic ability and community involvement. Please have the document labeled in the format Lastname\_Firstname\_Recommendations.

- One letter should be from a teacher who is best able to judge your college potential
- One letter should be from someone who has either supervised you, is involved with you, or witnessed your service to the community.

**Applications and ALL supporting information must be submitted electronically  
no later than March 30, 2024.**
